#### **Basic description**

This workshop is actually *a combination of three short technology workshops* offered through the Division of Information Technology (DoIT) and LinkedIn Learning and available to all UW-Madison students with an active UW NetID. DoIT typically offers twenty to thirty such workshops per semester, in the areas of web, data analysis, graphic design, programming, productivity and multimedia, and any LinkedIn Learning tutorial also counts toward Distributed Technology Workshops.

This option provides a way for PFMP students to complete their professional skills workshop requirement in the way they feel is most useful in light of their concentration area and individual research. To complete this option, each student chooses, enrolls in and completes three different technology workshops, based on availability and on the student's own preparation for the internship hunt and job market in his or her field.
